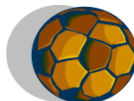

MEMBERSHIP DUES

& ELIGIBILITY

Membership dues are \$12.00 per year.
Applications are accepted at all locations;
boys/girls between the ages of 6-18
are eligible to join. Birth certificates may be
required of incoming 6 year olds.
Membership cards are required when
attending all Boys & Girls Clubs.

*Actual business cost of a single youth membership
amounts to more than \$450 per year.
The cost difference is provided by support
of the Great Futures Campaign, Government
Grants, Sponsorships, Earned Income,
Corporate Gifts, and other Private Donations.*

MEMBERSHIP CARD POLICY

All members are required to have their
membership cards in their possession
when visiting Boys & Girls Clubs.

Here are just a few reasons why:

- **ATTENDANCE & RECORD KEEPING:** cards are electronically scanned.
- **EQUIPMENT UPKEEP:** members exchange cards for use of equipment; cards are returned when equipment is returned in good condition.
- **TEACHING PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY:** Members learn the importance of keeping up with their cards in order to belong and participate.
- **BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT**
Misbehaving members risk losing privileges afforded with carrying a Boys & Girls Club Card.

Lost or abused cards may be replaced
for a fee of \$1.00 at all locations.
